

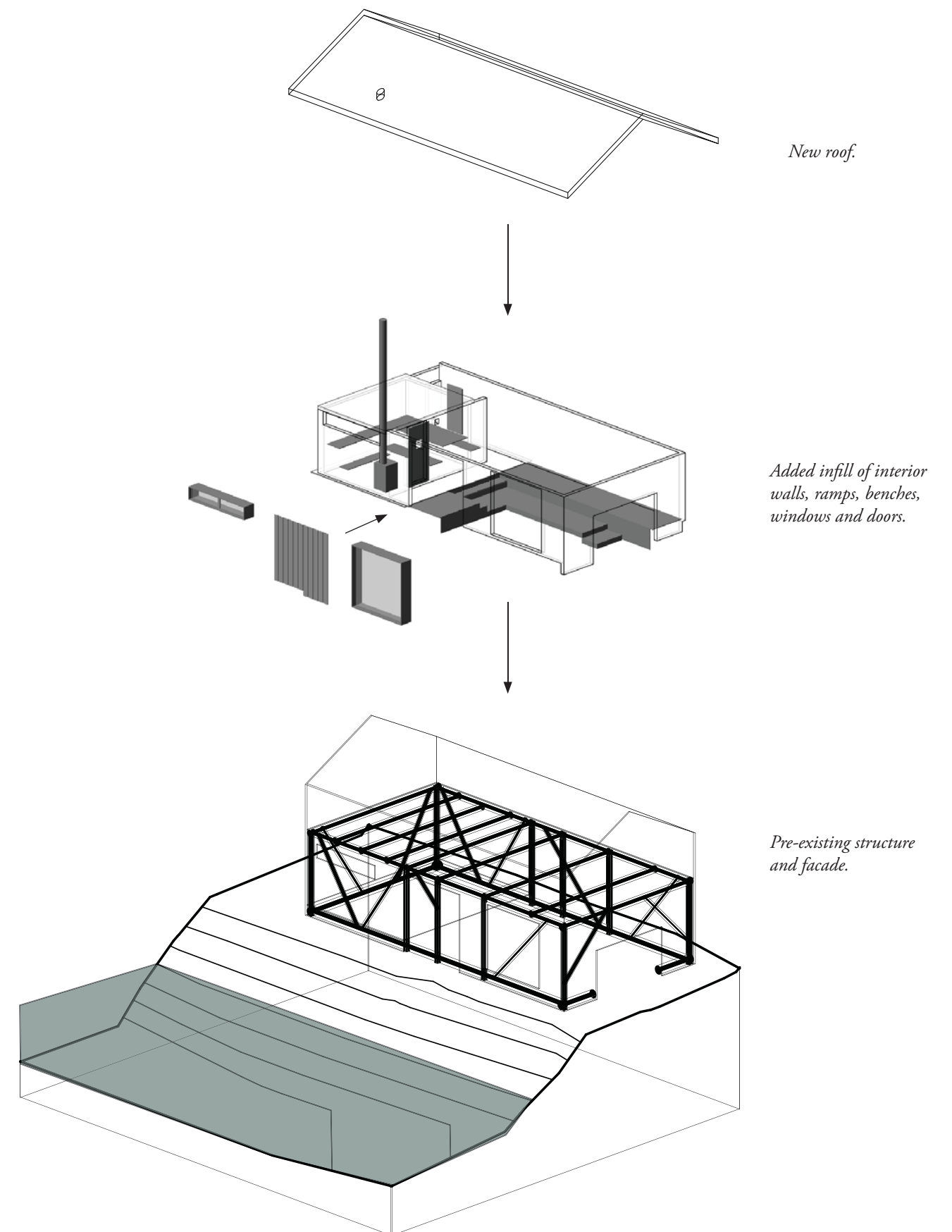
NAUSTET

Inside its skin was built a meeting place for use by the inhabitants of Trøna and its visitors.

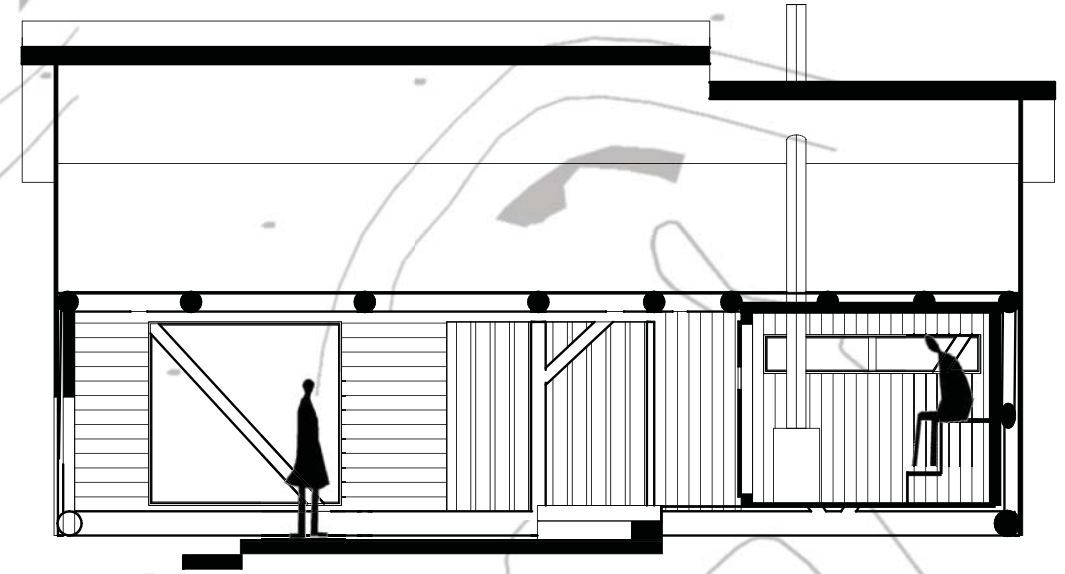

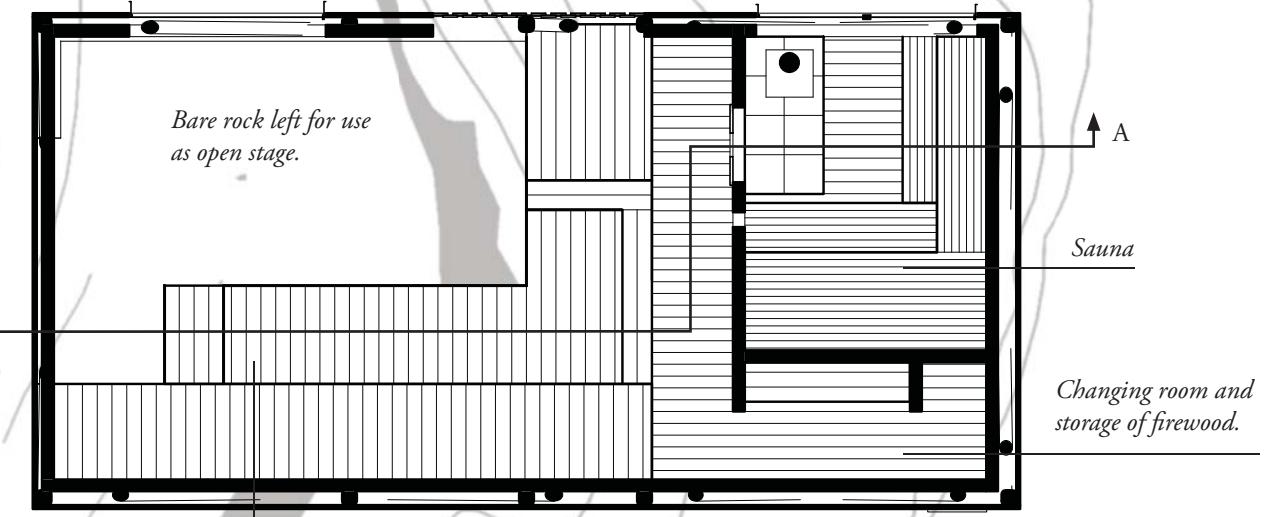
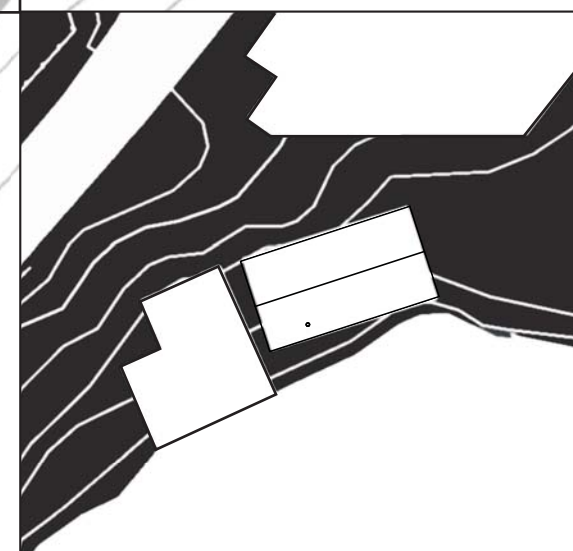
